



In Russia, the death rate is higher than the birth rate. Many children end up as orphans or social orphans because their parents are unable to take care of them.

Each year, Russia releases orphans into society after they turn 16 years old. With no skills, they must find a job, a place to live, and a way to survive. Most don't.

Ninety percent of these graduate orphans end up in crime, prison, prostitution, drug addiction or homeless. Within the first five years 5% have committed suicide.

Medical services in Russia are often limited, especially in government institutions where recourses for orphans have boundaries. Just imagine what it's like for a child to be sick in a state institution without adequate medication.

In October of 2004 we brought medications for the first time to Children's Hospital #15 along with our other ministry sites. The director of the hospital thought it was Christmas! You can bring this kind of joy to children and medical workers alike by helping to provide non-prescription medication. It's very simple and exciting for individuals, mission organizations, or Bible study groups to participate personally in a foreign mission project. Many doctor's offices or pharmacies may have samples on hand that they would just throw away. All you need to do is ask! ## 4 Easy Steps

1. **GATHER** the non-prescription medications from the list below and place them in zippered plastic bags. Feel free to bring any other non-prescription items not on the list in a separate zippered plastic bag.
2. **REVIEW** the expiration date on the medication. Place expired medications in one bag and unexpired medications in another bag. The Children's hospital we minister to can only accept unexpired medications.
3. **BRING** your non-prescription medication to the collection center listed to the left.
4. **PRAY** for the children who will receive this medication to help comfort them during their time of sickness.



## Medication Shopping List

Some of the items SAC needs and has taken before are:

- Cough Suppressants pills
- Cold & Cough medication pills (liquid meds are too heavy to transport)
- Vitamins
- Allergy medication
- Lice Shampoo (this will prevent boys & girls heads being shaved to remove the lice)
- Scabies medication
- Aspirin / Tylenol / Advil
- Neosporin
